**UPDATE ON JUSAG STRIKE OVER PAYMENT OF ARREARS OF SALARIES**

Following the announcement by the Judicial Service Staff Association of Ghana (JUSAG) to embark on an indefinite strike from Monday, 19th January 2026 over Government's delay in the payment of eight (8) months salary arrears to staff of the Judicial Service, Government has responded to the demands of JUSAG.

In view of the above, the planned strike has been suspended pending implementation of the payment plan by the Government.

Staff of the Judicial Service are, therefore, admonished to attend to their normal duties as we monitor progress of implementation.
